# BEYOND REASONABLE DOUBT

Jeffrey Archer wrote this play (his first) in 1987, following the General Election. It went on to play at the Queen's Theatre in London's West End for over 600 performances.

### **SYNOPSIS**

In the Central Criminal Court, the Old Bailey Sir David Metcalfe, distinguished QC and Chairman of the Bar Council, is conducting the most important defense of his career - his own.

Accused of the wilful murder of his terminally ill wife, Sir David finds himself locked in legal combat with his old rival, Sir Anthony Blair-Booth QC, prosecuting counsel.

After a tense and gripping courtroom scene, Act I ends just as we are about the hear the jury's verdict. Act II takes us back in time to the fateful night of Lady Metcalfe's death and before, and the plays ends with a surprising twist.



#### **LISA MARTIN**


